Here's a snapshot of the Beyond the Net program changes for 2022

What's new

Increased grant amounts

\$5K for Small Grants

Up to 50K for Large Grants (for eligible chapters)

Longer project time frames

Up to nine months for Small Grants

24 months for Large Grants (\$30K)

36 months for Large Grants (\$50K)

Flexibility regarding number of active projects

A Chapter may now have up to one Large, two Small, and one IGF active projects at one time

Revised criteria for assessing grants

Streamlined reporting

One report due at the end of Small grant period

Consolidated 12-month reports and payments for Large

Pilot opportunity through Small Grants

Support with Large Grant applications

More feedback channels

What it means to you

Additional time, money and flexibility to successfully complete projects

Updated grant criteria that is clearer and more transparent for applicants

Less onerous reporting requirements

Opportunity to "test out" a Large grant idea first (using Small grant funds), so that a subsequent Large grant application becomes more viable

Targeted assistance from the Foundation to Chapters applying for Large Grants in 2022
